

Summer Scholarships Now Available!

DEADLINE TO APPLY APRIL 22, 2016

COSI Scholarship:

apply through CCA Foundation online application

- Have a completed Financial Aid Application on file with CCA (FAFSA)
- Be seeking Degree or Certificate completion at CCA
- Be classified as a Colorado Resident for tuition purposes
- Be classified as a US Citizen
- Be within 250% of PELL eligibility based on the determined Estimated Family Contribution (EFC)

Fall-To-Fall Summer Scholarship:

apply through CCA Foundation online application

- Have been enrolled for both Fall 15 and Spring
- Be enrolled in minimum of 6 hours for Summer 16
- Show intent to enroll in a minimum of 6 hours for Fall 16
- Meet general FA requirements including MAP/SAP
- May be pell or non-pell eligible

Early Childhood Education Scholarship:

apply through Financial Aid Office

- Be in a declared ECE program of study at CCA
- Priority given to students who
 - Enroll in a minimum of 6 hours applicable toward their degree or certificate
 - Are near degree completion
 - Are currently employed in the field of Early Childhood Education

Daniel's Boundless Opportunity Scholarship:

apply through Financial Aid Office

- Be at least 25 years of age or older
- Be nearing degree completion **OR** be a new student in your first semester
- Meet general Financial Aid eligibility requirements to include SAP/MAP
- Be registered for Internship course for Summer 2016 **OR** have participated in at least one of the following groups for the 1516 aid year
 - TRiO
 - Transfer Success
 - Brother-to-Brother

Every scholarship application will ask for a **personal essay** but only **some** will ask for at least one **letter of recommendation**. Read each application **thoroughly** to ensure you **meet all requirements** and **complete** each step of whichever application you **submit**

Essay Guidelines: 500-800 word essay describing the following items.

- A brief biography of yourself including your academic and career goals and why have you decided to pursue these goals.
- Participation in activities at school, in clubs, or community service organizations and how it contributed to the organization and to your personal growth.
- Why you are applying for a scholarship and why you should be given one. Include any special circumstances (such as financial need or family situations that the selection committee should consider).

Letters of Recommendation:

These letters should be from individuals who can speak to your academic potential and career goals. It is suggested that letters be from a professional source such as school, work, ministry, etc.
