

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Throughout the course of the 2018-19 school year, Denver Online High School will be hosting free field trips for students every month. Full-time Denver Online High School students will be invited to participate in these events in order to develop community with their peers and teachers at DOHS. Some activities will also provide participants with academic credit as well. Transportation and admission are provided for free for our students. However, all food/drinks must be supplied by students if they wish to eat during the field trip.

By signing this permission slip, you are allowing your student to ride the bus from Smedley Learning Center to the location of the field trip and back to Smedley Learning Center. You are also giving permission for the student to participate in the field trip activities:

- Dinosaur Ridge: Fossil Traces in Swampy Places workshop and tour
- Chatfield Farms: Corn maze, hay ride, and other fall activities
- Puzzah Escape Room: Solve puzzles in order to unlock clues to “escape” from a room (*students always have a safe and accessible way out)
- Rocky Mountain Arsenal Wildlife Refuge: Build-A-Bison, feeding ferrets, and scouting for wildlife
- Capital Tour: Tour of the State Capital
- Jumpstreet: Jumping on trampolines, playing dodgeball, and swinging into a foam pit
- Denver Mint: Tour of how coins are made
- Shakespeare Festival: Participate in the parade and watch outdoor Shakespeare plays
- “Sweat” Play at the Denver Center for Performing Arts: Watch the play “Sweat”

We have a limited amount of space available per field trip, so field trips will be on a first come, first served basis in most circumstances. When information is sent out about each field trip, there will be an RSVP link posted for each trip. All students must RSVP through that link in order to attend. If more students RSVP than field trip space allows, then academic standing will be considered. Those students who are on track in their courses will have precedence to participate over those students who are off track in their courses. Students also must be on time for the field trip or their spot may be given to another student.
